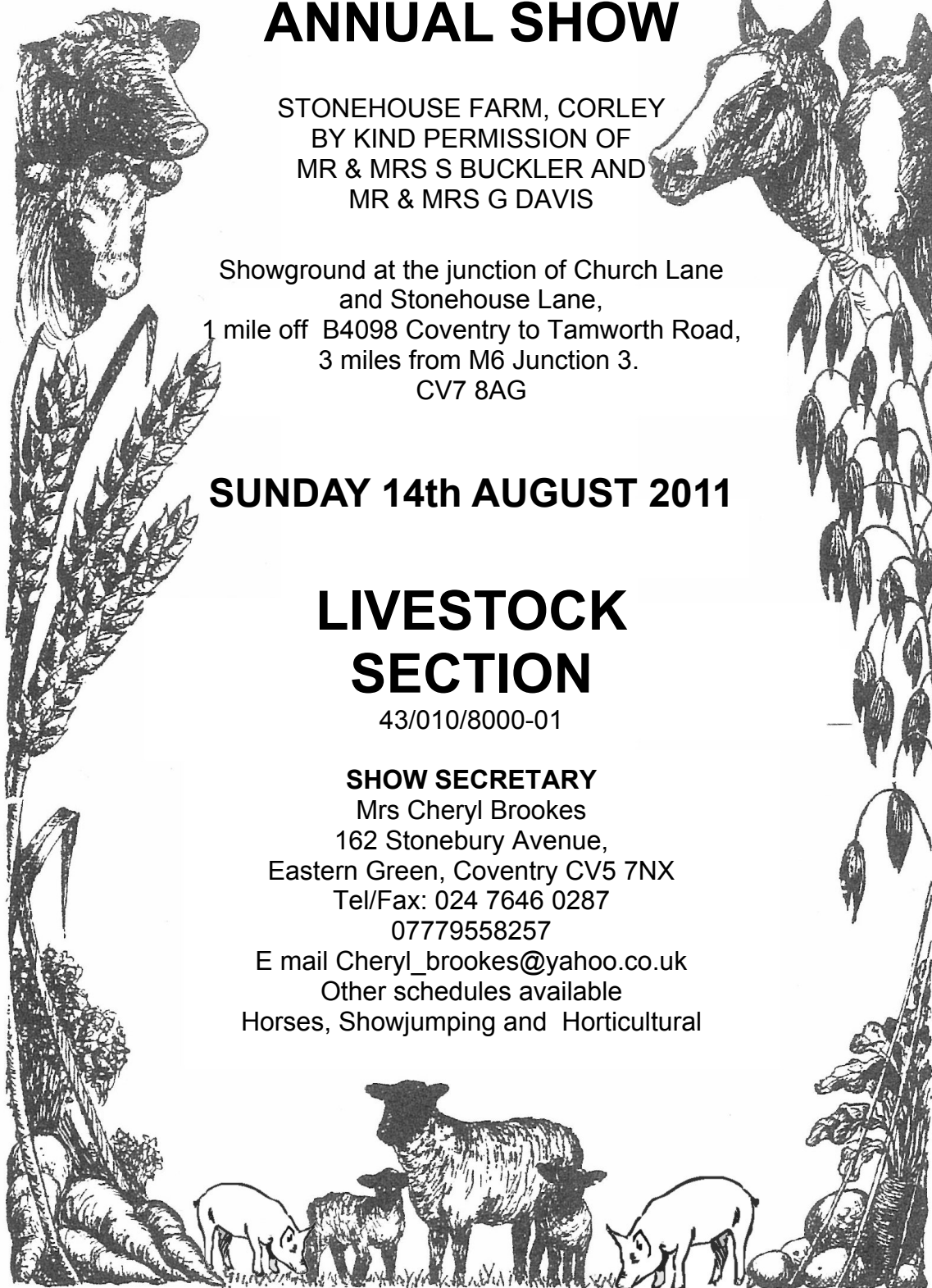

1. ALL ANIMALS MUST ARRIVE ON THE SHOWGROUND BETWEEN 8AM AND 9AM AND MUST NOT LEAVE THE SHOWGROUND UNTIL 4PM.
2. ALL EXHIBITORS MUST BE AWARE OF ALL THE REGULATIONS CURRENTLY BEING ENFORCED BY DEFRA.
3. ALL CATTLE MUST BE SHOWN IN A NATURAL CONDITION WITH NO ARTIFICIAL AIDS.
4. UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED HEIFERS MUST NOT SHOW MORE THAN 6 BROAD TEETH ON SHOW DAY.
5. ALL VEHICLES MUST BE CLEAN WHEN ARRIVING ON THE SHOWGROUND.
6. MUCKING OUT OF VEHICLES IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED ON THE SHOWGROUND ON SHOW DAY.
7. ALL BIO SECURITY RESTRICTIONS MUST BE ADHERED TO.
8. THE STEWARDS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY TO THE SHOWGROUND OR RING.
9. CERTIFICATE OF STATUS FOR THE SHEEP CLASSES MUST BE AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION BY THE STEWARD PRIOR TO UNLOADING OF VEHICLES.
10. THE SOCIETY RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY TO ANY EXHIBITOR WHO DOES NOT COMPLY WITH ANY OF THE REGULATIONS LAID OUT.
11. AN EXHIBITOR WHO ENTERS 2 OR MORE ANIMALS IN ONE CLASS MAY ONLY CLAIM 2 PRIZES WITH THE EXCEPTION OF PIG CLASSES.
12. ALL CATTLE AND SHEEP MUST BE LED BY HALTER, UNLESS SPECIFIED.
13. ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORMS OR WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
14. NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.
15. IN ALL CLASSES 1ST PRIZE MAY BE AWARDED ACCORDING TO MERITS OF EXHIBITS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE JUDGES.
16. ALL EXHIBITS ARE SHOWN AT THE OWNERS OWN RISK AND NO RESPONSIBILITY WILL BE HELD BY THE SOCIETY FOR ANY DAMAGE OR INJURY CAUSED TO OWNER, EXHIBITOR, HANDLER, STEWARD, ANIMAL OR MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC.
17. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A SHORT LEAD IN THE VICINITY OF THE LIVESTOCK AND KEPT OUT OF THE SHEEP LINES
18. IF ENTRIES ARE INSUFFICIENT CLASSES MAY BE AMALGAMATED
