## **Livestock General Regulations**

1. All animals must arrive on the Showground between 8am and 9am and not leave the Showground before 4pm.
2. All cattle must be on a halter before being unloaded from vehicles. Sheep and pigs must have hurdles in place to prevent escaping.
3. All exhibitors must be aware of all the current regulations being enforced by DEFRA.
4. All cattle must be shown in natural condition with no artificial aids.
5. Unless otherwise stated, Heifers must not show more than six broad teeth on Show Day.
6. All vehicles must be in clean condition on entering the Showground.
7. Mucking out of vehicles is strictly prohibited on the Showground on Show Day.
8. All bio security restrictions must be adhered to.
9. The Stewards reserve the right to refuse entry to the Show Ground or Show Ring.
10. No cattle are to remain on the showground for a period of 24hrs or more. Cattle are not housed nor on hardstanding.
11. The Society reserves the right to refuse entry to any exhibitor who does not comply with any of the regulations laid out.
12. All cattle and sheep must be led by halter unless otherwise stated.
13. Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by the appropriate entry fee.
14. In all classes 1<sup>st</sup> Prize may be awarded according to the merits of the exhibits at the discretion of the Judge.
15. An exhibitor who enters two or more animals in a class (with exception of pigs) may only claim two prizes in that class.
16. All exhibits are shown at the owner's risk and the Society accepts no responsibility for any damage or injury caused to owner, exhibitor, handler, steward, animal or member of the public and their property. All exhibitors must have appropriate Public Liability Insurance.
17. All dogs must be kept on a short lead in the vicinity of any livestock and are to be kept out of the sheep lines.
18. If there are insufficient entries, classes may be amalgamated.

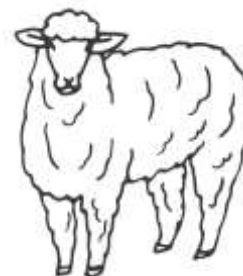

## **General Regulations and Information.**

The Poultry Show will be held in accordance with the rules of the Poultry Club of Great Britain.

All exhibitors must cleanse and disinfect their show boxes, crates or baskets before the event and be advised to do the same on return to the home premises. Disinfectant foot dips must be used on arrival and when leaving. Please ensure footwear is suitable for foot baths.

Only birds entered in the show or sale will be allowed in the poultry tent.  
Continued

Whilst every care is taken, the Society cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage to birds, eggs or equipment during the show.

The Society reserves the right to alter times stated if deemed necessary.

Birds whose condition causes concern to judges or stewards will be removed and isolated. With the H5N8 Avian Flu outbreak over the winter, it is essential that effective biosecurity measures are exercised. Entrants can be reassured that the Society will consider the safety of holding the poultry show and will take all steps to ensure biosecurity measures are in place where possible. Only birds which appear in good health will be admitted to the poultry tent.

No exhibitor may approach the judges prior to or during judging.

The decision of the Committee and of the judges is final.

## **POULTRY SALE**

Only pre-entered birds are allowed in the sale.

No other birds will be allowed in the poultry tent.

Sale pens are available at £5 per pen for each sale.

Maximum 3 large birds/6 bantams per pen.

Poultry Show entrants will be given priority.

Sale birds must be penned between 7.30am and 8.45am on show day only.

No late arrivals. Sold birds must remain in pens until after show judging.

All sale birds are entered at the owner's risk.

A Poultry For Sale board will also be available on the day - £1 per card.

# Poultry/Eggs Entries

## POULTRY ENTRIES

A completed entry form with full payment must be sent to the Poultry Secretary (details inside cover) to arrive **no later than Monday 6th August**.

Exhibitors with **5 or more entries** in the poultry section (not eggs) will receive **one** complimentary adult ticket to the show, **if a stamped, self-addressed envelope is enclosed with the entry form**. Only one ticket per exhibitor.

Entry Fee per bird - £2

## EGG ENTRIES

Entries can be

- pre-entered (using the egg entry form), or
- entered on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> August between 4 - 6.30pm in the Poultry Tent, or
- Show Day Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> August between 7.15am and 9am.

**No entries will be accepted after 9am.**

Egg entries left overnight in the show tent are at the owners' risk.

## ARRIVALS

All poultry entrants **must** use the main public car park where a Forward Parking Area, close to the poultry tent, will be available. Vehicles can remain there free of charge all day. Stewards will be available to assist with loading/unloading if required.

## JUDGING

The poultry tent will be cleared at 9.15am for judging to commence. Any birds not penned by this time will be excluded from judging.

The tent will be closed to all exhibitors and the public until judging has commenced.

No exhibitor may approach the judges prior to or during judging.

The decision of the Committee and of the judges is final.

## COLLECTION

Exhibits may only be removed from pens from 4pm onwards.

Stewards will assist if required.

## SECURITY

Once penned, exhibits shall only be handled by judges or, if deemed necessary, by stewards. Birds will be watered by the stewards after judging. Exhibitors must advise in advance if they prefer to water their own birds.
